



A/2nd Entry Team Tryout Guidelines

All KMHA players must be registered in order to attend tryouts.

Tryout fee of \$85.00 for all KMHA or NRP players

(KMHA players can cover this cost when registering online or Walk-in clinics – see KMHA website)

NON-RESIDENT PLAYERS – Players outside of KMHA Boundaries

Non-Resident Players (NRP) are eligible to attend our A tryouts starting at U12 up to and including U18 divisions only. Any NRP player who does not have a signed passport from their home centre will not be allowed on the ice, these are done electronically through your home center rep.

Players in divisions below U12 that are within KMHA boundaries are only eligible to play travel hockey within KMHA and are unable to play travel hockey in any other centre. Please contact the Ontario Minor Hockey Association with any inquiries regarding this policy.

NRP (Non-Resident Players) who are released from our A tryouts cannot tryout for our 2nd Entry team program.

KMHA Players:

All KMHA players wishing to play in our 2nd Entry team must attend A tryouts. A verbal release from the A Head Coach must be obtained as well as approval by the VP of Travel. For player development purposes, KMHA would like all players to play at the highest level possible within our travel program.

KMHA Players requesting NRP passports for tryouts in an B Centre:

You must have attended and have exhausted all reasonable efforts and avenues by attending our A tryouts. Please contact the VP of Travel prior to attending 2nd Entry Team tryouts if you plan on attending an outside B center.

KMHA Players requesting NRP passports for B or below:

KMHA players must attend and have exhausted all reasonable efforts and avenues by attending our A and/or 2nd Entry Team tryouts. Please contact the VP of Travel to obtain your NRP passport.
